1. Introduction

- From June 3rd 2025, FAI Connect has introduced a self-registration process for Player Registrations.
- All players currently registered with a club need to sign up to FAI Connect with a MyComet Player Account. The link to send to players to sign up is here:

<https://faiconnect.ie/mycomet/public/signup>

- Players who are currently with a club and are moving clubs from July 1st 2025, can then either self-register to initiate the transfer, or the new club they are joining can initiate the transfer.
- Players who will remain with their current club do not need to re-register with their current club
- Clubs can create or use the template Self-Registration link to be given to the new players.

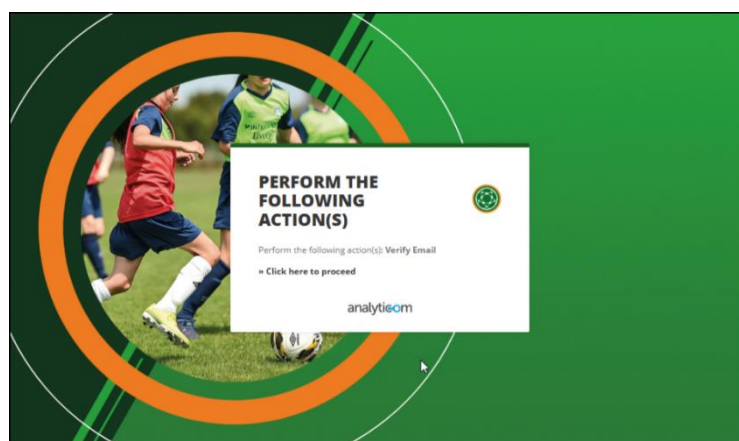
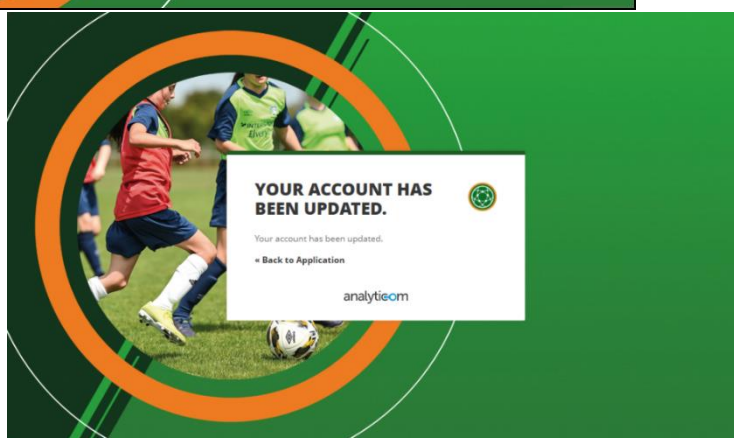
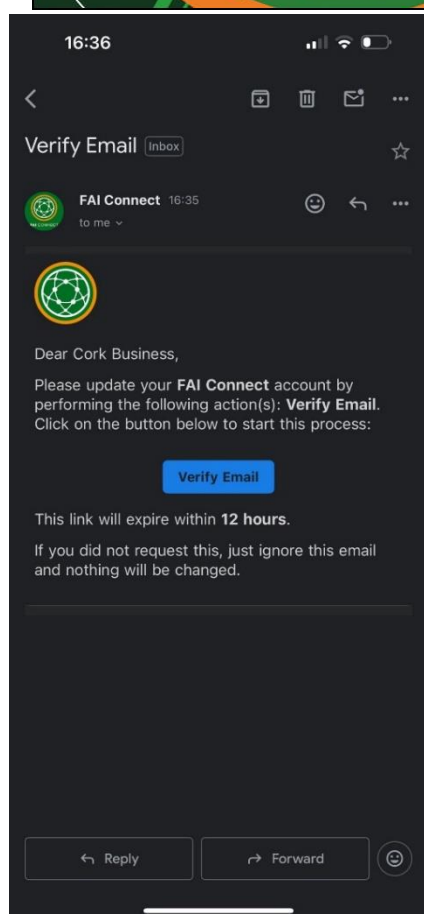
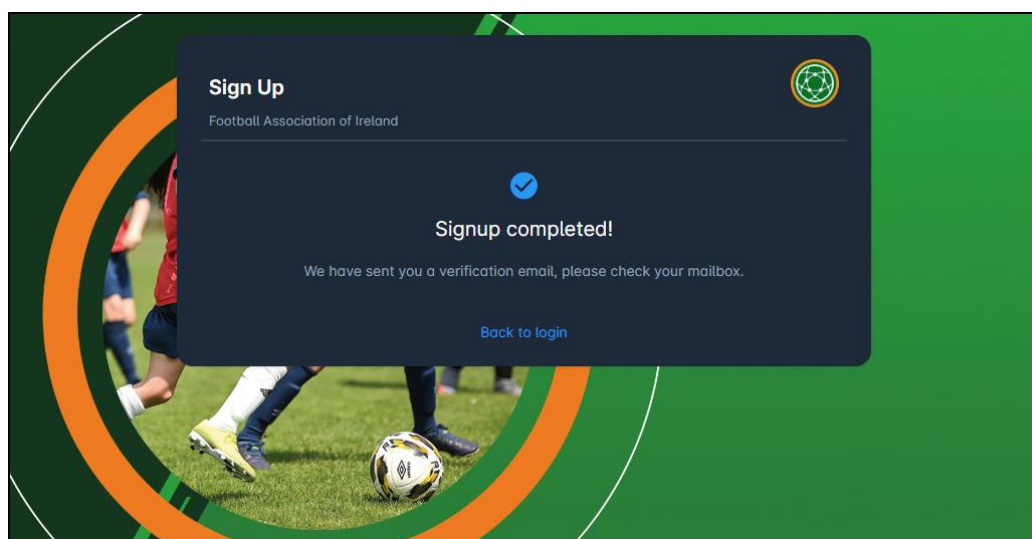
Step	What to do
1	Sign up at https://faiconnect.ie/mycomet/public/signup
2	Complete profile & upload photo
3	Go to Registrations → Self Register
4	Choose Club → Click Ok
5	Upload ID or clearance documentation
6	Submit, and monitor emails for updates

2. Creating a new MyComet Player Account

2. Once signed up you will received a Verification Email and on screen confirmation.



3. Creating an Account where no user account exists but there is existing Player Registration that matches.

- If the details that you have entered match an existing Player Registration record however the email address is blank and / or it differs from the existing email address on FAI Connect for your player registration, please contact your club to update the email address on your record, and then you will be able to register and login.



- If the profile on screen that is returned is not yours, then click on the checkbox to create a new profile.

4. Creating an account where an existing User account exists but a different email address is being used.

- If you are trying to create an account with the same Forename, Surname and Date of Birth as an existing profile linked to an Account on FAI Connect your profile should appear to continue to Login. If you do not know your password, click Forgotten Password on the login page (you should then receive an email with instructions).



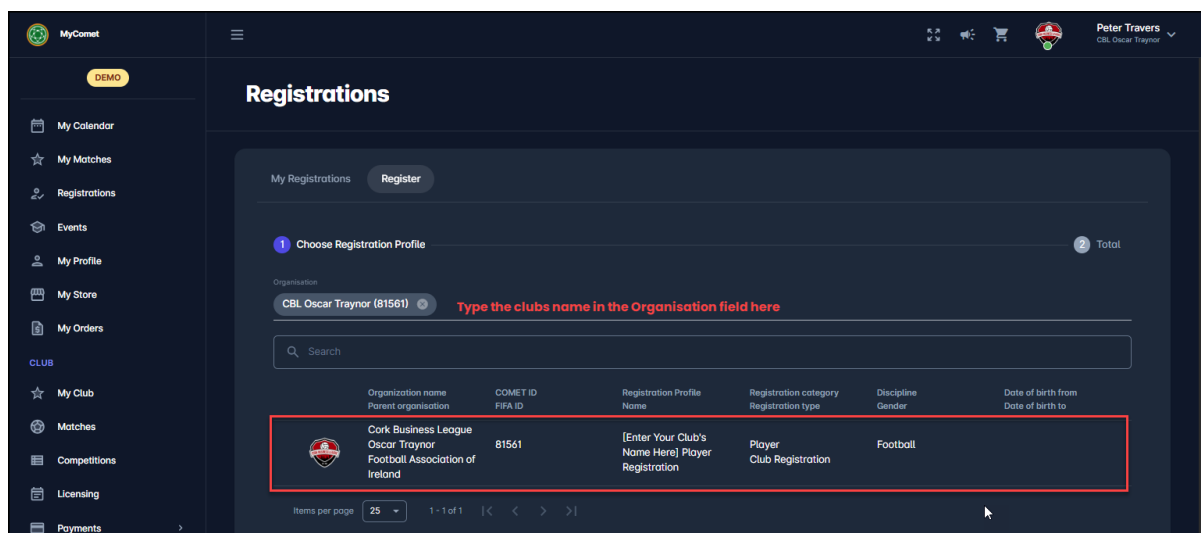

5. Finding a Club's Self Registration Profile

Option A: Finding the club

1. Login to <https://faiconnect.ie/mycomet>
2. Go to the Registrations tab and then click on the Register button.
3. All Club's Active Self Registration profiles will then appear here, profiles are essentially the different options to register to that club in that Category i.e. Player/Coach/Staff/Official.
4. Be sure to check the Registration Category you select is correct if a club appears more than once. (i.e. if there are Player Registration Profiles and Coach Registration Profiles.

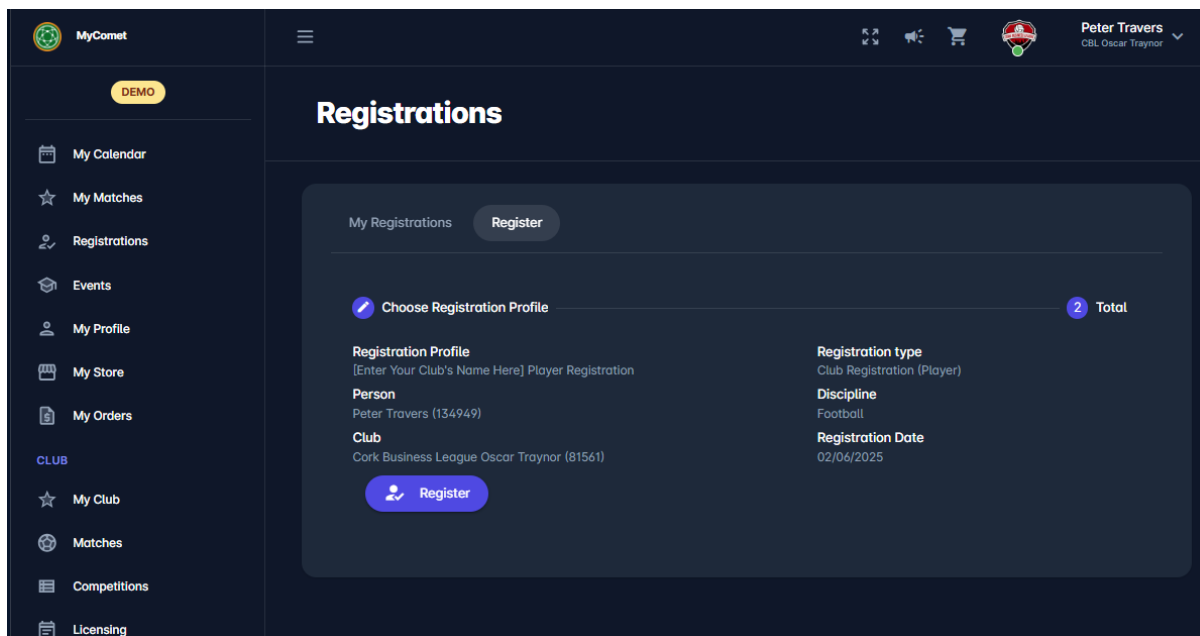


Option B: Follow a Self-Registration Link received from the Club

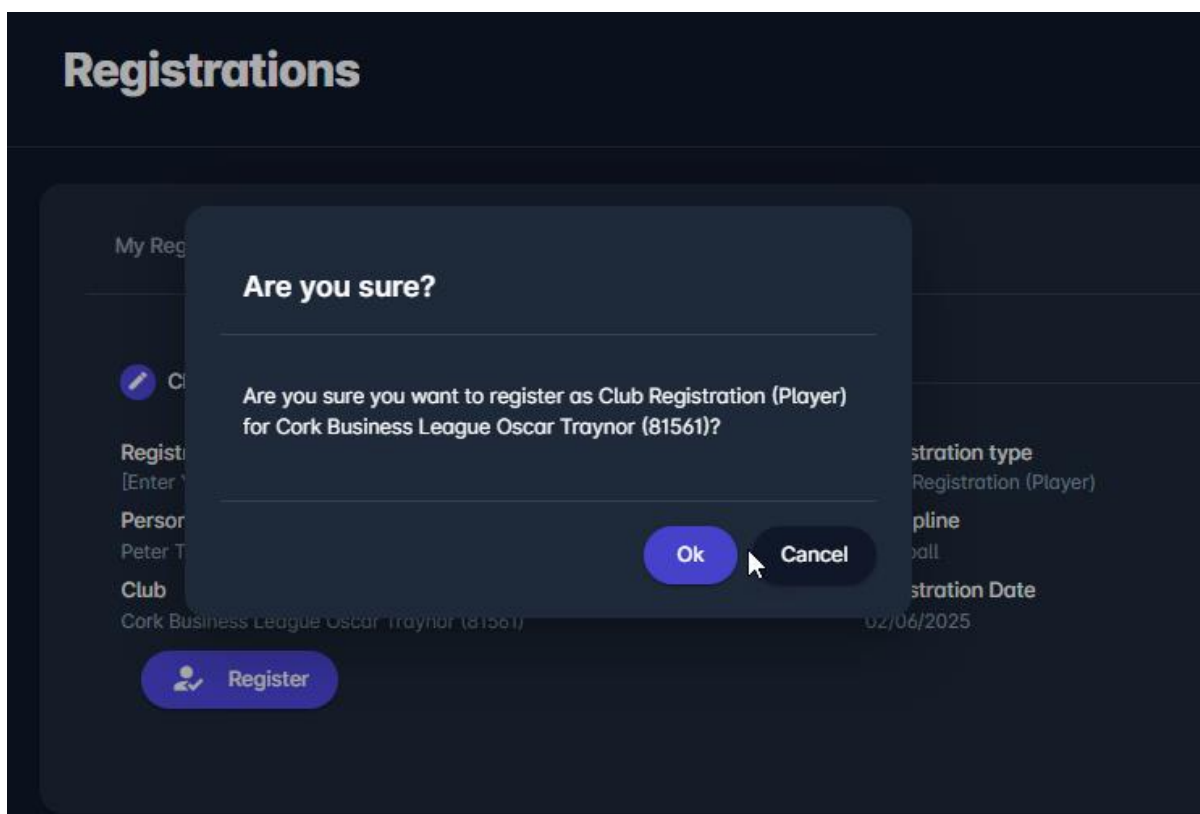
1. Click on the Self-Registration link that you have received from the club.

6. Entering your Registration to a club via the Self Registration Profile

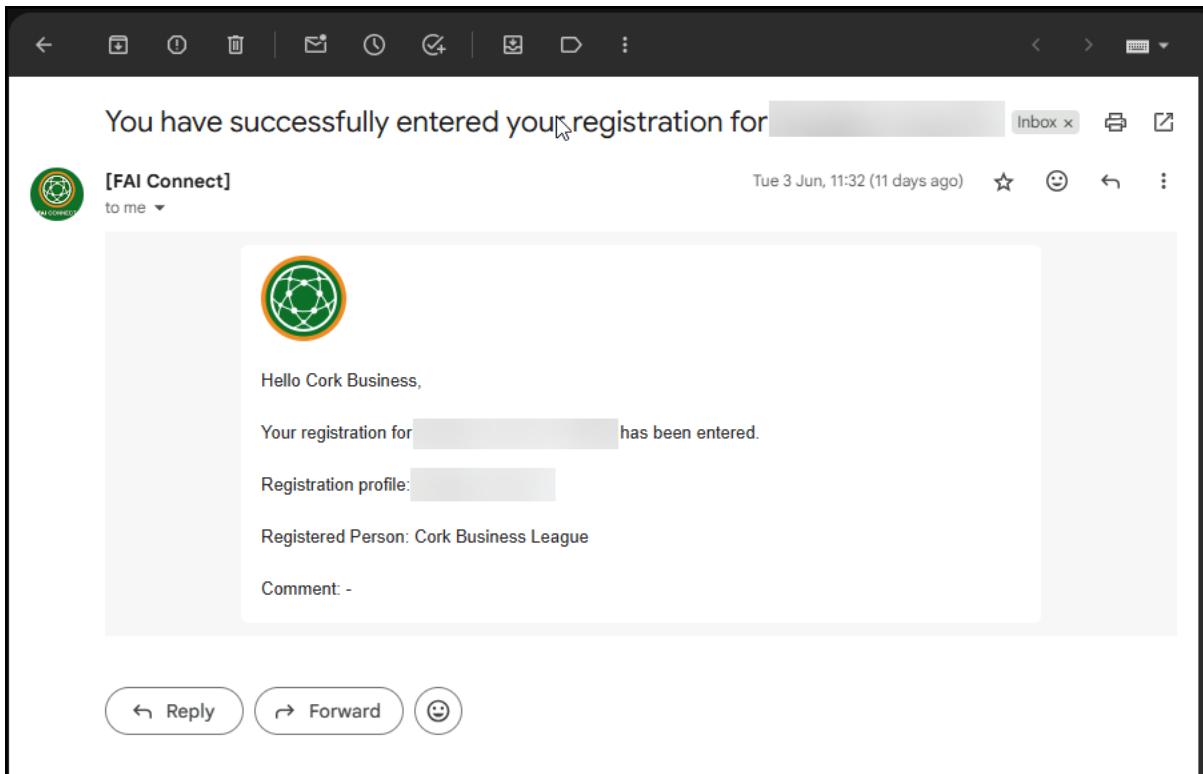
1. Ensure the Registration Profile is correct
2. Click the Register button



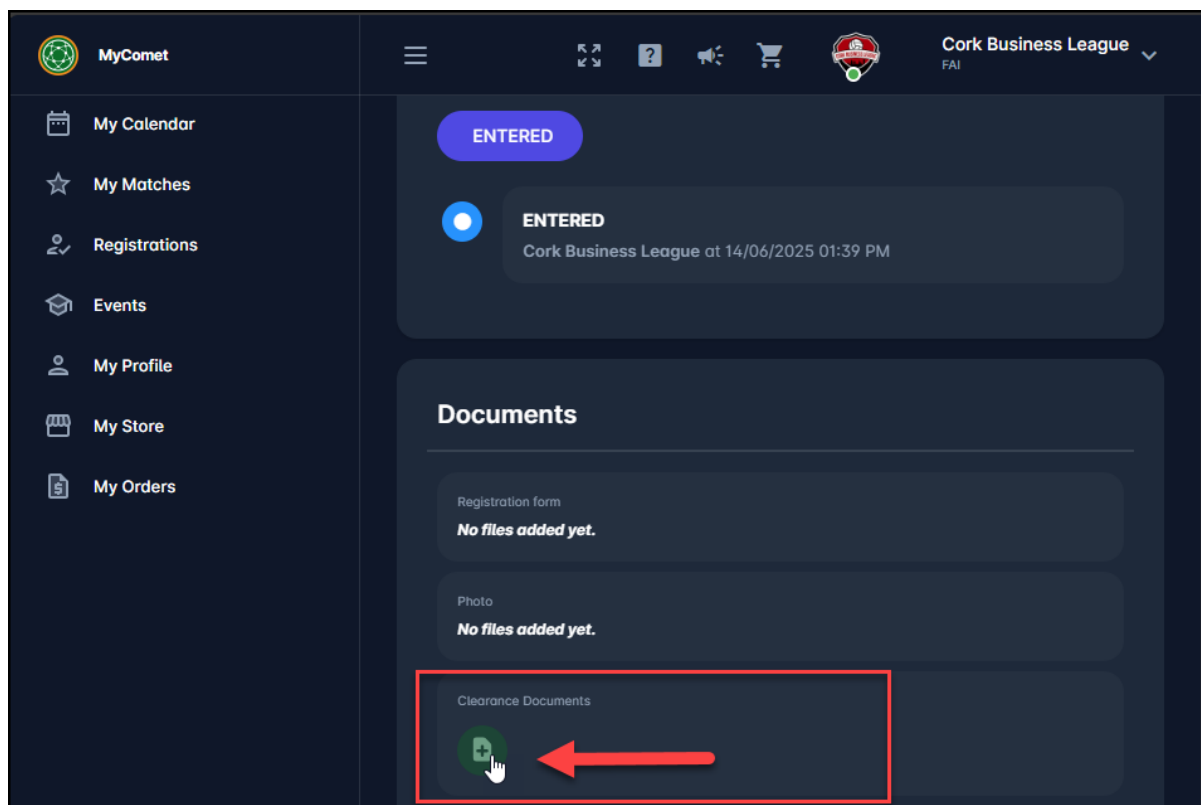
3. Click the OK button on the “Are you sure” pop up message.



4. You have successfully Entered a registration to the club, they will also be notified by email that your registration is Entered.



5. Mandatory Step: If certain documents are required, you will have the ability to upload them here to Clearance Documents yourself i.e. ID Document for FAI Admin to verify your profile prior to first registration.



You have now done everything you can as a player to Self-Register to a club. Your club will SUBMIT your registration to the FAI for Approval and until this registration shows as CONFIRMED you are not a Registered player with the club.
